WHAT IS THE YOUNG OFFICIALS AWARD?

The Young Officials Award comprises of two elements:

Youth Umpire Award (soon the officially renamed as Young Umpire Award) and

Young Match Bench Officials (under development)

YOUNG UMPIRE AWARD

AIM: To promote the development of Young Officiating

TARGET GROUP: 13-18 Year olds delivered through Specialist Sports Colleges / Partnerships and in the near future CAPS clubs

WHY?

- To improve an understanding of the Game
- To introduce the generic skills of umpiring (foundations laid with progression to 'C' Umpire Award)
- To offer opportunities for Talent Identification (linked to PESSCL Gifted and Talented Programme)
- It will fulfil the National Curriculum requirements at Key Stage 3 & 4
- When accepted with Sports Leaders Awards Scheme and Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme will provide opportunities for progression.

HOW?

- To provide a quality assured program delivery will be a two / three hour pre course workshop for teachers and club personnel of CAPS accredited clubs
- Students course: Minimum six-hour delivery, tutored by teachers and in the near future club personnel of CAPS accredited clubs.
- Completion of Workbook with competencies.
- Practical umpire assessment – pass/defer.

DELIVERY:

Stage 1 – 2/3 hour Orientation Workshop either for Teachers organised through Specialist Sports College structure and in the near future for Club personnel organised through CAPS Clubs in County.

Tutors identified by England Netball.

Stage 2 – Minimum 6 hour delivery by teachers within the school curriculum and in the near future club personnel (all of whom must have attended a YUA Orientation Workshop).

Course may be delivered during lesson time or in after school sessions, candidates' complete Workbook Resource with competencies. (CAPS clubs will eventually deliver this during training sessions).

Stage 3 – On completion of the Workbook, a practical assessment – pass/defer. Assessors to be identified by England Netball via the county.

WHERE NEXT FOR YOUTH UMPIRES?

Accredited Young Umpires will be able to umpire within their own age group and below. They will hold their qualification until the end of the season when they turn 18 years of age. Upon recommendation, qualified Young Umpires may move directly to 'C' Award Assessment. If successful they would not have to attend a Netball Europe C award umpiring course.

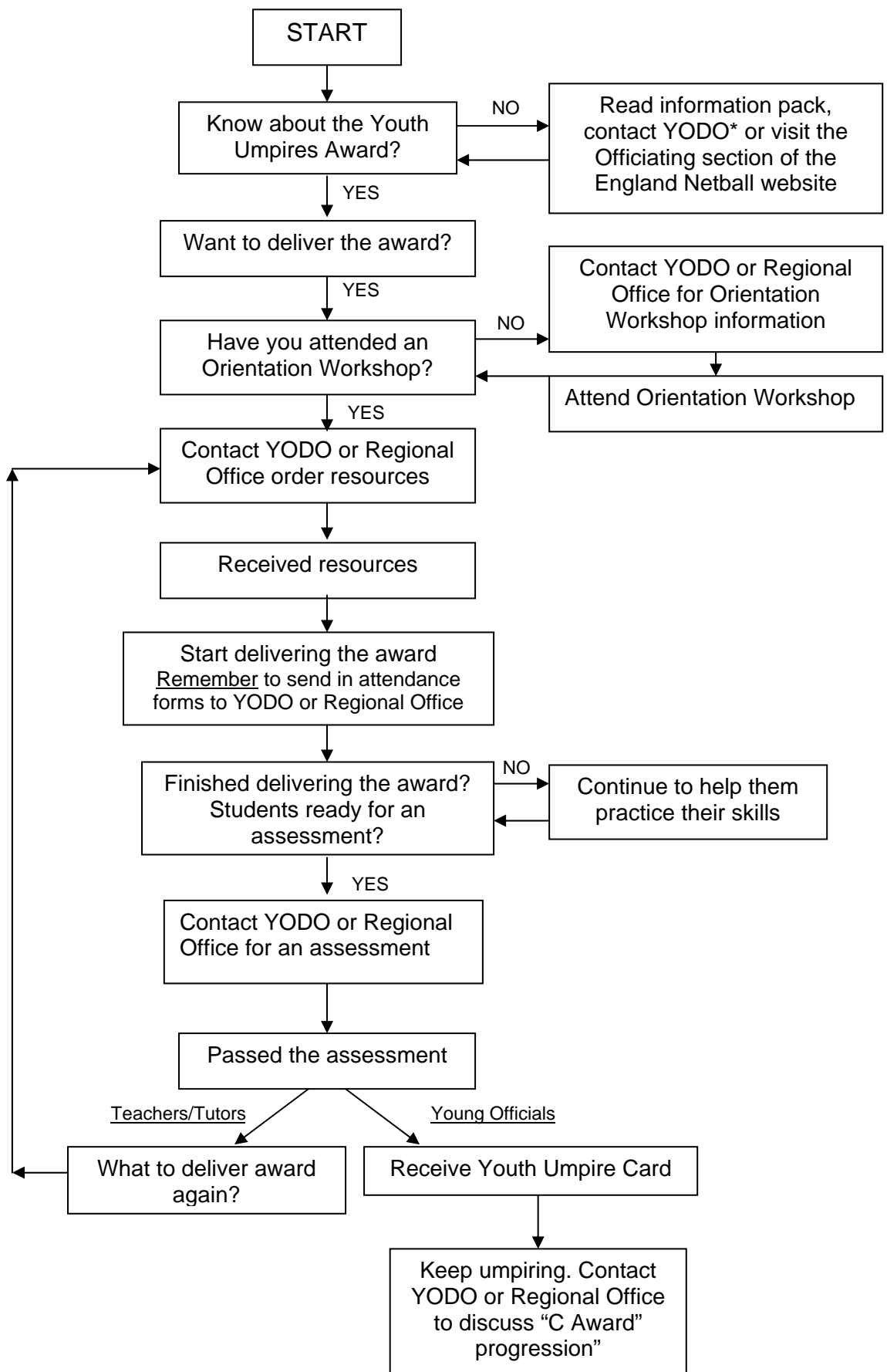

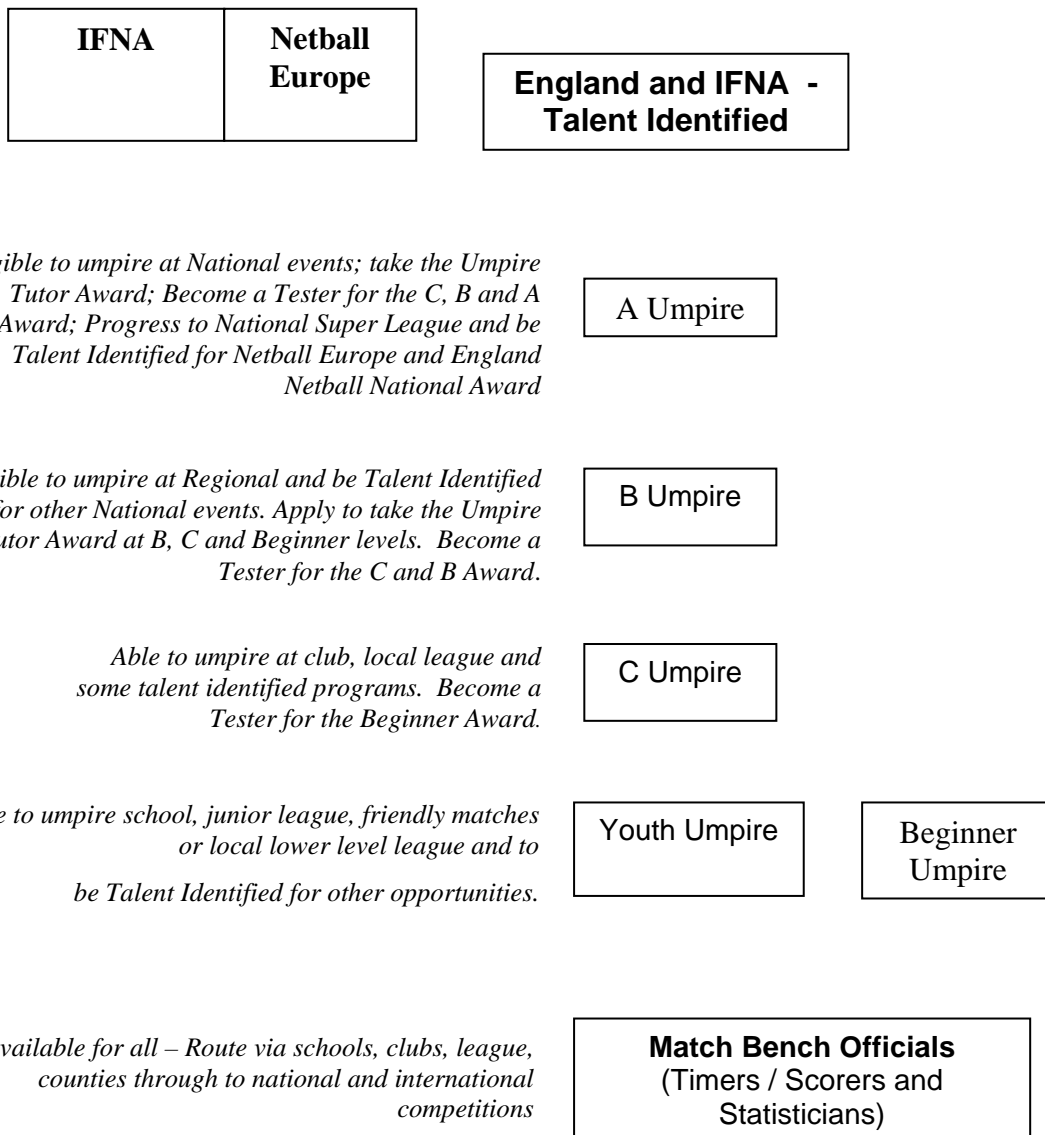
YUA TUTOR – CRITERIA
