'A Game for Me'

Placing cricket at the heart of our communities

- 1. Kwik Cricket Competition This will be based on the Kwik Cricket format. It will be 8 aside teams and aimed at KS3 & KS4.
- 2. Super 1s Festival The children will again be a team of 8 children. They can be from KS 2-4. Before lunch the children taking part in this festival will rotate around a series of cricket related activities that will be based on Super 1s activities. After lunch the children will use the skills learnt in the morning to play an adapted cricket based game such as "caterpillar cricket" or "bats". Staff coming with the children will need to be ready to adapt and improvise on the activities as they rotate around the stations so that they fully fit the needs of their team.

 There is excellent parking at the venue as well as disabled toilet facilities. It will be played on grass and is open to all ages.

Children will need to wear suitable clothing and to bring lunch and drinks.
